10		<i>Citrus</i> subg. <i>Papeda</i>	Citrus subg. <i>Papeda</i> indicates the subgenus <i>Papeda</i> of the genus <i>Citrus</i> , with citrus species native to Asia. The <i>papeda</i> group includes some of the most tropical, and also some of the most frost-tolerant citrus plants. They are cultivated far less often than other citrus, though they will all hybridize with other citrus.  This group contains about 15 species.

13	Desert Lime	<i>Citrus glauca</i>	Found in lowland subtropical rainforest and dry rainforest areas of Queensland and New South Wales, Australia. Early settlers consumed the fruit and retained the trees when clearing for agriculture. Commercial uses include boutique marmalade and restaurant dishes, and is exported for such.
14	Etrog	<i>Citrus medica</i>	
15	Finger lime	<i>Citrus australasica</i>	The finger lime has been recently popularised as a gourmet bushfood. Finger lime is thought to have the widest range of colour variation within any <i>Citrus</i> species.
