1	1 January	Restoration Day of the Independent Czech State; New Year's Day	Den obnovy samostatneho ceskeho statu; Novy rok	The independent Czech Republic was created in 1993, after dissolution of Czechoslovakia.
2	March, April	Easter Monday	Velikonocni pondeli	Easter is celebrated for two days (Sunday and Monday) in the Czech Republic
3	1 May	Labour Day	Svatek prace	
4	8 May	Liberation Day	Den vitezstvi or Den osvobozeni	1945, the end of the European part of World War II
5	5 July	Saints Cyril and Methodius Day	Den slovanskych verozvestu Cyrila a Metodeje	In 863, Church teachers St. Cyril (Constantine) and Metodej (Methodius) came from the Balkans to Great Moravia to propagate Christian faith and literacy.
6	6 July	Jan Hus Day	Den upaleni mistra Jana Husa	The religious reformer Jan Hus was burned at the stake in 1415.
7	28 September	St. Wenceslas Day (Czech Statehood Day)	Den ceske statnosti	In 935, St. Wenceslas, Duke of Bohemia, now patron of the Czech State, was murdered by his brother.
8	28 October	Independent Czechoslovak State Day	Den vzniku samostatneho ceskoslovenskeho statu	Creation of Czechoslovakia in 1918.
9	17 November	Struggle for Freedom and Democracy Day	Den boje za svobodu a demokracii	Commemorating the student demonstration against Nazi occupation in 1939, and the demonstration in 1989 that started the Velvet Revolution.
10	24 December	Christmas Eve	Stedry den	Christmas is celebrated during the evening of the 24th.
11	25 December	Christmas Day	1. svatek vanocni	
12	26 December	St. Stephen's Day (Czech: "The Second Christmas Day")	2. svatek vanocni
