

SNo	Date	Name	Explanation
1	1 January	New Year's Day	Festival marking the beginning of the new year.
2	6 January	Epiphany	Commemorates the visit of the three Wise Men or magi to the infant Jesus.
3	5 February	Feast of Saint Agatha	Commemoration of St. Agatha, Patroness of the Republic, as well as liberation from foreign rule.
4	variable *	Easter	Resurrection of Jesus.
5	variable **	Easter Monday	Monday after Easter day.
6	25 March	Anniversary of the Arengo	Anniversary of the Arengo and the Festa delle Milizie (Feast of the Militants).
7	1 May	Labour Day	Celebration of workers and employees.
8	variable ***	Corpus Domini	Commemoration of the body and blood of Jesus Christ.
9	28 July	Liberation from Fascism	Commemoration of the fall of the Sammarinese Fascist Party.
10	15 August	Ferragosto (Assumption)	Commemoration of the Virgin Mary's assumption into heaven.
11	3 September	The Feast of San Marino and the Republic	National feast of San Marino, celebrating the origin of the Republic in 301.
12	1 November	All Saints' Day	Feast dedicated to all saints.
13	2 November	Commemoration of all those who died at war	Remembrance of all those who gave their lives for San Marino in war.
14	8 December	Immaculate Conception	Remembrance of the Virgin Mary's conception without original sin.
15	24 December	Christmas Eve	Day before the commemoration of the birth of Jesus.
16	25 December	Christmas	Birth of Jesus.
17	26 December	St. Stephen's Day	Commemoration of the death of Saint Stephen, the first Christian martyr.
18	31 December	New Year's Eve	Celebration which closes and marks the end of the year.

\* Easter: the first Sunday after the full moon and the March equinox

\*\* Easter Monday: the Monday after Easter day

\*\*\* Corpus Domini: the first Thursday after Trinity Sunday
